Notes To Students and Parents

- 4. A cursory reading of the book is not adequate preparation for the book test given on the first Monday after school starts. The following suggestions should prove helpful for the study of summer reading books:**
 - a. As students read, they should make notes about content.**
 - b. Underlining and writing in the margins of personal copies of the books are ways to note the most significant material.**
 - c. Students should write a brief summary of each chapter and make a list identifying major characters.**
